



Great Lakes Lotus Club Technical Inspection Form

Our first priority is your safety and the safety of others on the track with you and for this reason we take the Technical Inspection Form very seriously and ask that you do not try to avoid or shortcut this safety requirement.

Prior to the Event

- The Inspection should be completed no more than one month prior to the event
- The Inspection should be completed AFTER your most recent track event.
- Please note that brake fluid must have been changed within twelve (12) months of the event.
- Please allow sufficient time to complete the Technical Inspection AND address any issues which arise!

At the Event

The Technical Inspection Form, completed and signed by a certified mechanic, must be brought with you to the track and presented at the Registration Desk. Unfortunately, due to time and resource constraints we are not able to complete Technical Inspections at the track.

If you do not bring a completed Technical Inspection form we will not be able to allow your car on the track. It is your responsibility to ensure that any repairs are completed and that your car passes Inspection.

Note that all cars remain subject to additional inspections throughout the event. Cars deemed to be unsafe to participate will be excluded until suitable repairs can be made.

Where can I get a Technical Inspection?

The Technical Inspection may be performed by.

1. A Lotus dealer such as Auto Europe (677 S. Eton, Birmingham (248-645-6300)
2. A recognized, independent mechanic, or other certified mechanic within your state. The mechanic should be familiar with your make or model vehicle

Auto Europe has kindly agreed to provide Technical Inspections to Great Lakes Lotus Club members free of charge. Please call Tom Schick at Auto Europe on (248) 645 6300 to schedule your Inspection.
